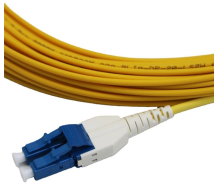

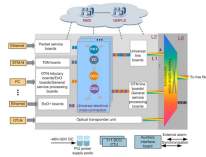

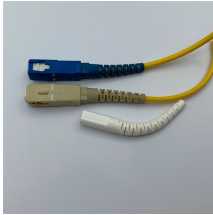
The Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTS) sets out the tariff rates and statistical categories for all merchandise imported into the United States.

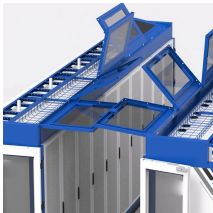

During subsequent escalating trade tensions between the United States and China, both nations applied tariffs exceeding 100 percent on imported goods.

These tariffs, ranging from 11% to 50%, rates are set to take effect on April 9, 2025. Many countries received a 90-day pause on tariffs where rates are increased to 10%.



If implemented, these new tariffs will increase costs on a wide range of imported goods, including materials essential to eyewear manufacturing and distribution.
