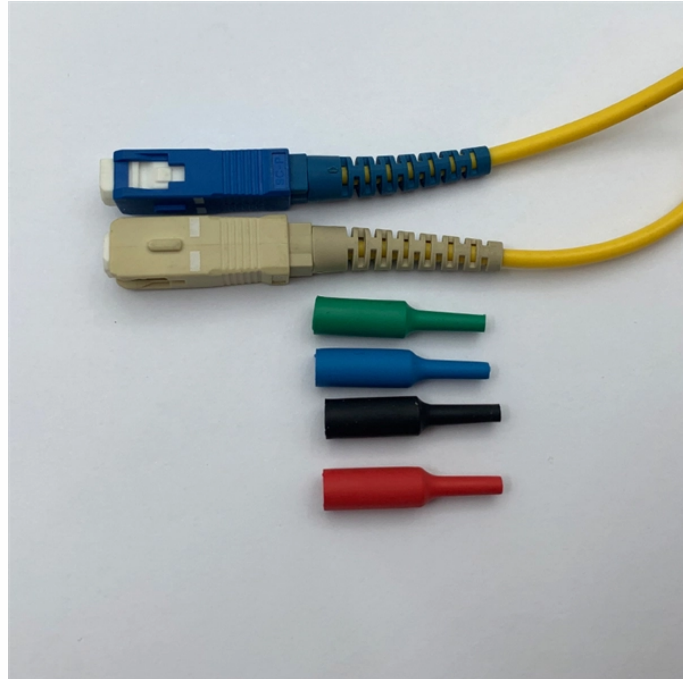


## Armenia Long-Span Bridge Construction



### Overview

Closed since August 20 for a major government-funded renovation, the bridge remains under construction as upgrades continue. The renovation includes resurfacing the roadway with asphalt concrete, waterproofing the overpasses and pavements, and installing a new drainage system. This was stated on the Facebook page of Armenian Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan. “The longest bridge in the history of Armenia — and not only of present-day Armenia, but in the history of the Armenian people — is.
