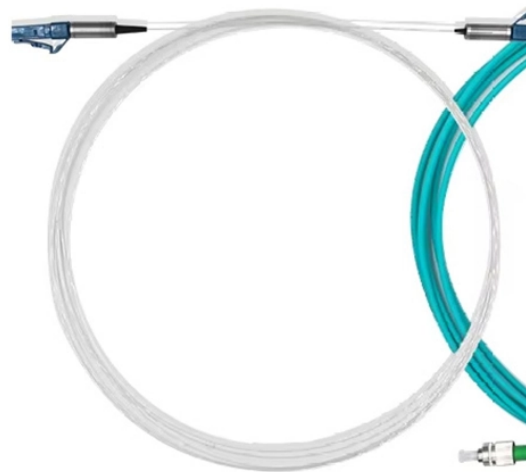


## Belgium to Congo Optical Cable
