An FC interface provides FC access to storage within the interface SVM using either Fibre Channel Protocol (FCP) or NVMe over FC (NVMe/FC). 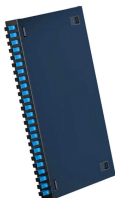

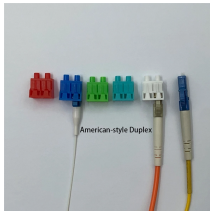
