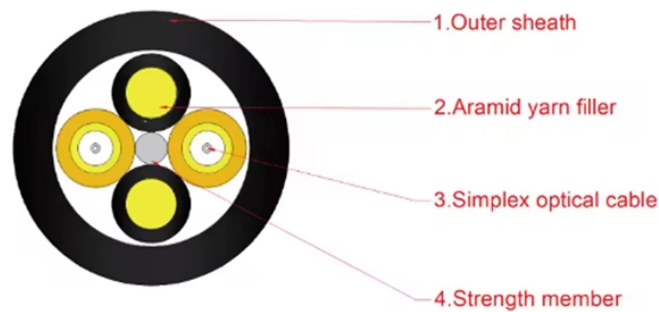


Fiber optic cable spliced at the terminal box

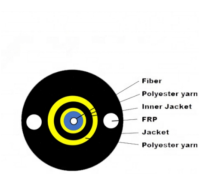

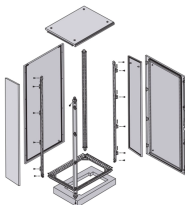

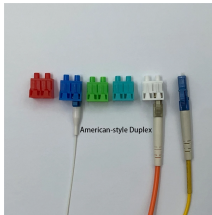
