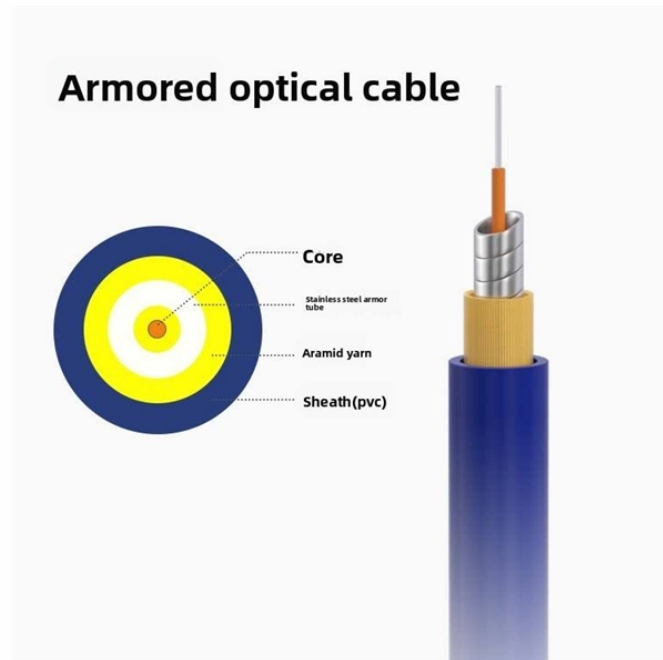

The regulations dictate that the cables must either be Type TC (also known as Tray Rated) or must be metal-armored (Type MC). 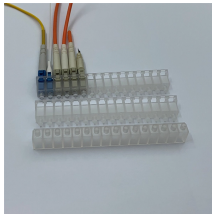
