

Height of meter box and distribution box



Overview

Wall-mounted boxes should be 4. This height makes it easy to reach without bending or stretching. Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches to avoid. The meter box is the meeting point between the utility grid and the building's electrical system. Residential installations typically follow recommended heights between 1. 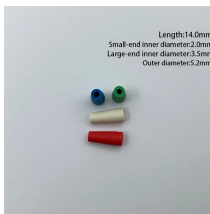
Install the meter box such that the bottom of the box is on the foundation. If the meter box cannot be located on the foundation (for example, as a result of a poured concrete porch or steps) ...



The National Electric Safety Code requires an unobstructed working space that extends from the floor or ground to a minimum height of 6 feet, 6 inches. For electrical equipment mounted higher than 6 feet, ...



However, most of them use industry standards that specify a minimum height of four feet (between the ground and the bottom of the meter), an ideal height of five feet (between the floor and the center of ...



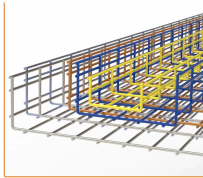

Ganged meters installed in meter rooms shall be mounted so that the center of the meter shall be not more than 72 inches and not less than 42 inches above floor level.

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Meter sockets shall be plumb and securely fastened to the building wall or structure. Meter sockets shall be installed four to six feet (4" – 6") above finished grade to the center of the meter. A minimum of ...
