

How to locate the distribution box for primary power supply



Overview

Bottom Line Up Front: Your home's distribution box (electrical panel) is typically located in the basement, garage, utility room, or mounted outside near your electrical meter. To find it quickly, look for a rectangular gray metal box about the size of a medicine cabinet, often positioned close to. The electrical panel is the central hub that distributes electricity throughout the house. Knowing where to find your electrical panel in your home helps in case of emergencies and routine maintenance. Typically, you'll find your home's main amperage inside the main electric panel, on a circuit breaker switch labeled "Main" or "Service Disconnect," attached or very close to your electric meter. Have you ever wondered how electricity is delivered to—and routed through—your house?

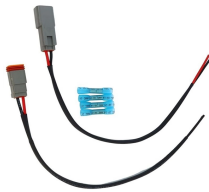

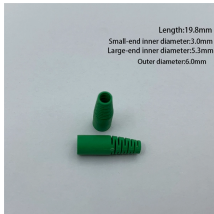
