

Is it okay for cables to arch when laid in cable trays



Overview

For licensed electricians, mastering these principles is essential. According to NEC Article 392. 10 (B) (1), the smallest size single conductor allowed to be installed in a cable tray is 1/0 AWG.

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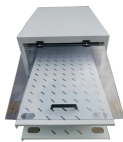
