The connector end plugs into devices like transceivers or patch panels, while the bare end is typically fusion spliced to a fiber optic cable. Think buffer tubes, strength members (FRP/steel/aramid), fillers/gel, ripcords, and outer jackets (PVC/LSZH/PE, OFNR/OFNP). Indoor tight-buffer: flexible routing, trays, risers, plenums. Professionals often prefer this method because it isolates issues, protecting downstream circuits from cascading failures. Why does this matter?

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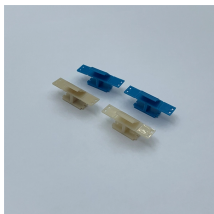
