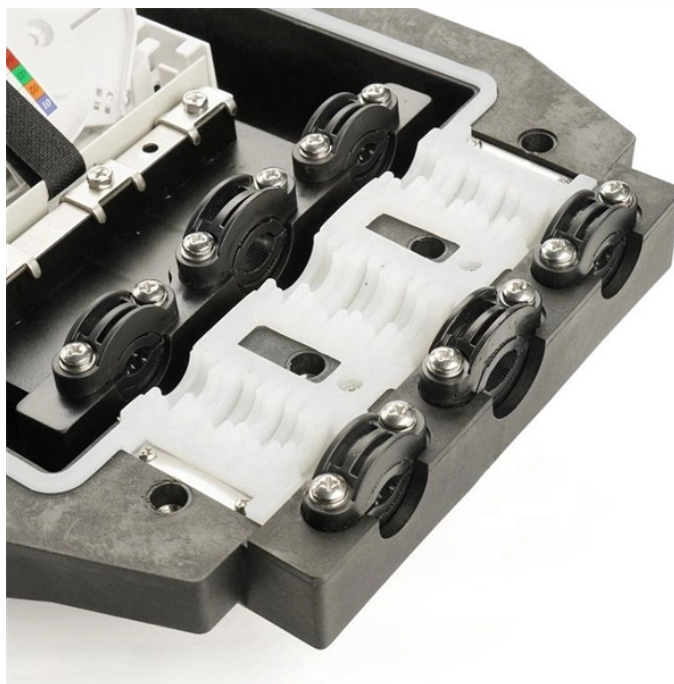


Network Rack Environment Requirements



Overview

This guide covers the technical requirements for modern rack deployments: Cat6A cabling for multi-gigabit infrastructure, thermal dissipation for high-power PoE devices, proper rack depth planning, and SFP+/DAC uplink configurations. A cabinet or rack must belong to one of the following types: Standard 19-in. Open racks depend on room-level cooling, while cabinets often require vented doors or active cooling to maintain proper front-to-rear airflow. 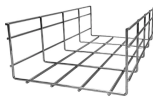
We do not recommend that you use racks that have obstructions (such as power strips), because the obstructions could impair access to field-replaceable units (FRUs).



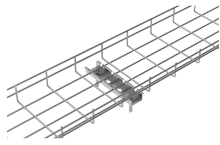
