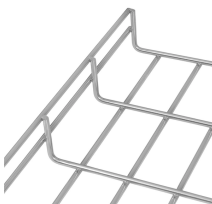
In order to effectively pull cable without damaging the fiber, it is necessary to identify the strength material and fiber location within the cable. Then, use the method of attachment that pulls most ...

Although most fiber optic cables are not conductive, any metallic hardware used in fiber optic cabling systems (such as wall-mounted termination boxes, racks, and patch panels) must be grounded.



Avoid placing fiber optic cables in raceways and conduits with copper cables to avoid excessive loading or twisting. Attach cables with plastic clamps having large surface areas.
