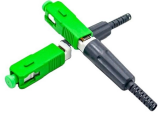

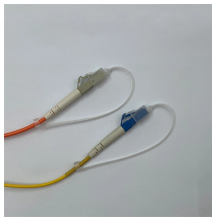

A fiber optic ring network is a physical or logical network topology where devices (usually switches) are. Fibre loops, also known as fibre rings, refer to a network setup where each node or building connects to the next in a loop formation using fibre optic cables. This circular arrangement creates a highly efficient, high-capacity network architecture with several notable advantages. Instead of running in a straight line from one point to another, the fiber forms a circular pathway linking multiple nodes.
