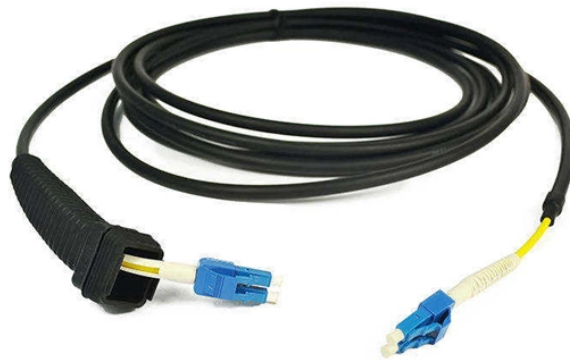


Sdh fiber optic communication transmission



Overview

Synchronous Optical Networking (SONET) and Synchronous Digital Hierarchy (SDH) are standardized protocols that transfer multiple digital bit streams synchronously over optical fiber using lasers or highly coherent light from light-emitting diodes (LEDs). Developed in the late 1980s by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), SDH was designed to replace the Synchronous digital hierarchy (SDH) and synchronous optical network (SONET) refer to a group of fiber-optic transmission rates that can transport digital signals with different capacities. This tutorial discusses synchronous transmission standards in world public telecommunications networks. Higher-level signals are integer multiples of STS-1, creating the family of STS-N signals, for $N = 1, 3, 12, 48, 192$ & 768 . The optical carrier part for each STS-N signal is designated as OC-N (Optical Carrier level-N).

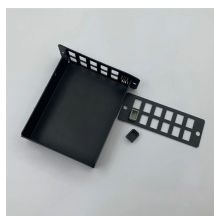
