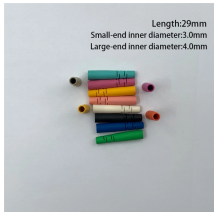

The export declaration or assessment decision allows you to reclaim the VAT for exported goods above a value of CHF 1,000.00. The authorities also use this information for foreign trade statistics.



Customs formalities are required at the border for importing dogs, cats, other animals, plants, weapons, cash or a loaned vehicle.



When in doubt, declare. Declaring goods is usually simpler than arguing later. Switzerland generally allows duty-free imports for private use or as gifts. However, some goods are ...
