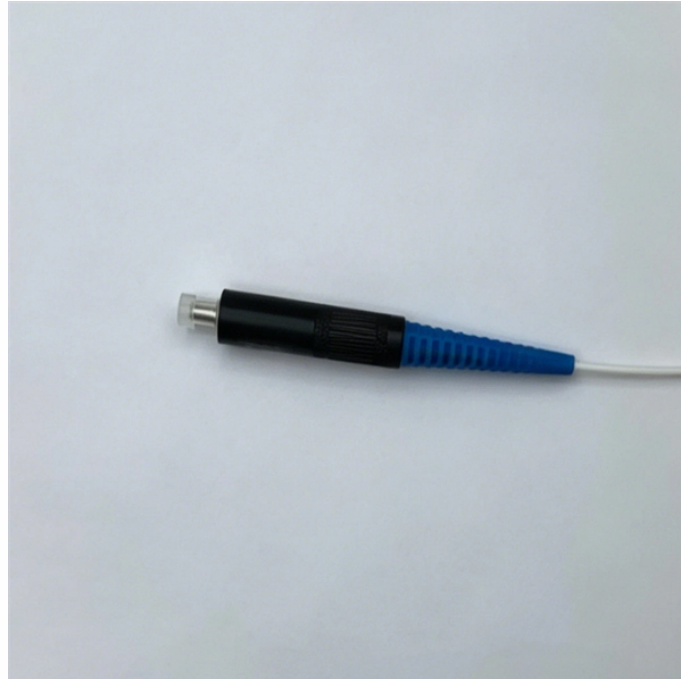


# Syria exports 1MWh high-efficiency UPS system CIF price
