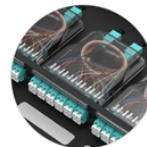

### Overview

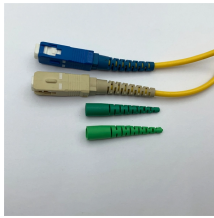
