The most common causes of this are loss of power to the fiber terminal (ONT) or an unplugged network cable. The other end of this cable should be plugged into the active wall jack or indoor. This guide will walk you through diagnosing and resolving common fiber network issues efficiently. Why Do Fiber Networks Fail?

Despite their robustness, fiber networks can fail due to: Physical Damage : Cuts, bends, or contamination in fiber cables or connectors. Hardware Failures : Faulty. If the status light ring is off (no color), it means your router is not connected to the network. It would go away by itself in a few seconds and come back online. Rarely you would see "green" settings on switches have issue on long cables. It will click when seated properly if it was unplugged.

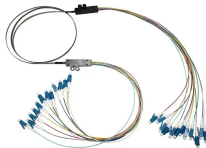
