Use a wide-toothed comb or a squirrel tail comb to gently separate and align the fibers. This will remove any tangles or matting, resulting in a more uniform appearance. 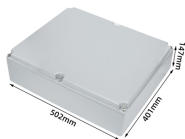

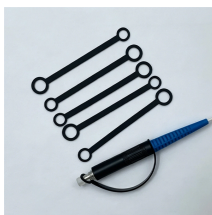
