

What are the metal components of a fiber optic connector



Overview

Unlike the plastic-bodied standard connectors (SC) and Lucent connectors (LC), FC connectors use a circular screw-type fitting made of nickel-plated or stainless steel. The function of fiber optic connectors is to align and connect two or more fibers together to provide a means for attaching to, or decoupling from, a transmitter, receiver, or any other fiber optic component. The connectors can be put on patchcords, pigtailed or components with single-mode (SM). Nearly all types of fiber optic connectors have the following components:

Connector housing – Sometimes called the connector body or external housing, the housing is the largest portion of the connector and holds the ferrule. Typically, the housing is made of plastic. We'll take an SC connector for example to illustrate the structure of the fiber optic connector.

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FC is the abbreviation of Ferrule Connector, indicating that its external reinforcement method is a metal sleeve, and the fastening method is a turnbuckle.



SC connector is built around a long cylindrical 2.5mm diameter ferrule, made of ceramic (zirconia) or metal (stainless alloy). A 124~127um diameter high precision hole is drilled in the center ...



Fiber optic connector consists of five components: fiber ferrule, connector sub-assembly body, connector housing, fiber cable, and stress relief boot. Below shows figure an example of an SC ...



A component within all fiber optic connectors is called the "ferrule." The ferrule ensures alignment during connector mating and is often made from a hardened material such as ceramic, stainless steel, ...



For an optical connector design, there are five key and important components: the fiber ferrule, the sub-assembly body, the connector housing, the fiber cable, and the stress relief boot.
