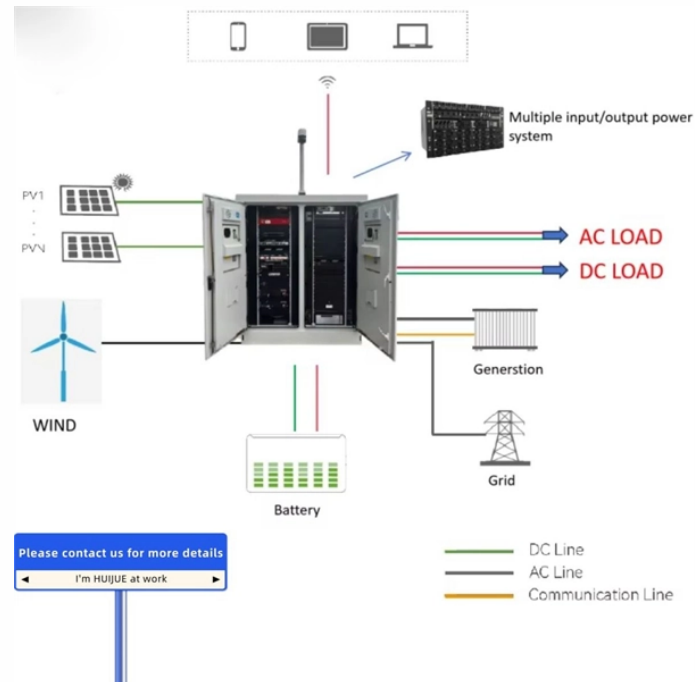

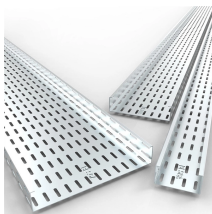

ANSI/TIA-568 is a technical standard for commercial building cabling for telecommunications products and services. The title of the standard is Commercial Building Telecommunications Cabling Standard ...



The following language is recommended for use in project documents: Fiber optic cables shall be installed in accordance with the FOA Standard for Installing Fiber Optic Cable Plants.
