It is a box with an inlet pipe to send the water from the tank and many outlet holes to disperse the treated water through multiple field lines. These outlet holes can be adjusted depending ...



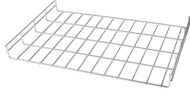
A septic tank's distribution box (or a D-box) is a container that receives the septic tank effluent and re-distributes it into the network of attached drain fields and pipes.

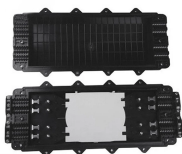
