

Which method is used for long-distance optical cable laying



Overview

On very long OSP runs (farther than approximately 2.5 miles or 4 kilometers), pull from the middle out to both ends or use an automated fiber puller at intermediate point(s) for a continuous pull. Directional drilling is currently the primary method for laying submarine optical cables. A small directional drilling machine can achieve a maximum length of approximately 300 meters when ...



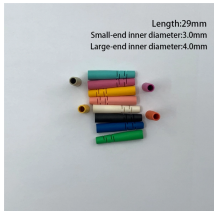
Overhead and Buried are the two main fiber optic cable installation laying methods. They both have advantages. Besides that, effective measures are essential for a cabling.



When laying cable out for a long pull, use a "figure-8" on the ground to prevent twisting. The figure 8 puts a half twist in on one side of the 8 and takes it out on the other, preventing twists.
