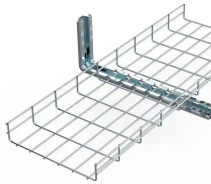
Wiring of a 32-position double-row distribution box

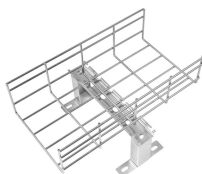

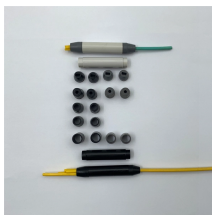
